Behavior Policy

Youth are expected to behave in a manner that reflects Christian values. All the values are based on the following rule: Show RESPECT for all adults, youth, yourself, and things that belong to others.

Rules of Conduct for Participants

1. Retreats should be a place where all can share without ridicule or fear of rumors.
2. Do not curse, insult others, or use body language that offends others.
3. Do not bring anything illegal to retreats (including drugs, alcohol or tobacco products of any kind).
4. Clean up after yourself!
5. Do not go into an area that is not supervised by the youth minister or by a SUPERVISING ADULT volunteer (including another persons automobile)
6. Dress appropriately.
7. No public displays of affection, including but not limited to kissing or holding hands. We are here as individuals not as couples.
8. Do not invade other people's space by wrestling with or touching anyone inappropriately.
9. Do not throw anything.

I understand that I am expected to live up to the behavior described above. If my actions fail to meet guidelines, I understand I can lose the privilege of attending this event.
