What is Euthanasia?

Reflection. The glossary of the Catechism of the Catholic Church defines Euthanasia as “an act or omission which, of itself or by intention, causes the death of handicapped, sick, or dying persons – with an attempt to justify the act as a means of eliminating suffering.”

Euthanasia is the taking of human life and thus is prohibited by the fifth commandment. It is a grave offense against the dignity of the human person and also against God, the Author of human life. While motives and circumstances can mitigate one’s culpability, they do not change the nature of this murderous act, which must be forbidden. (Catechism, no. 2277)

Prayer. *Heavenly Father we believe in the dignity of the human person. We pray for the grace to, ‘unite our sufferings with those of Jesus Christ, for the sake of His Body the Church’ (cf Col. 1:24).*
