REFLECTION: On October 8 & 9th 1871, the Blessed Virgin Mary

appeared to Sister Adele Brise, a young Belgian emigrant. The Queen of Heaven gave Sister Brise a twofold mission: to pray for the conversion of sinners and to catechize children.

Exactly 12 years after the apparitions, the Peshtigo Fire in Wisconsin, the worst fire ever recorded in North America, destroyed 1.5 million acres and took over 2,000 lives. Sister Adele gathered the children and people in the Chapel of Our Lady of Good Help and began praying the Rosary. The chapel sat on 5 acres, surrounded by a wooden fence, where the people placed their livestock. The chapel, wood fence, cattle and people were miraculously saved from the raging fire. The conflagration was a colossal natural disaster. The surrounding 1.2 million acres were completely incinerated.

On Jan 22, 1973 an enormous cultural disaster occurred in the United States of America. The Supreme Court issued its Roe v Wade decision, ushering in abortion on demand in America. Our nation has suffered the death of nearly 60 million preborn children since the decision. However, through praying the rosary, the St. John Paul II Pro-Life prayer and performing good works every day; the cultural of life will prevail.
