DID THE COURT FIND THAT LIFE DOESN'T BEGIN UNTIL BIRTH? No. It argued that uses of the word "person" in the Constitution do not seem to include the unborn. Then, citing wide disagreement as to when life begins, the Court said it "need not resolve" this difficult question. Instead of considering scientific evidence that life begins at conception, or even allowing legislatures to protect those who have never been proven to be anything but human beings, the court decided to treat unborn children merely as "potential life" – and to prevent the people and their elected representatives from determining otherwise.




