

Reflection – On **Saturday November 3, 2018, beginning at 10 am**, the Saint James Respect Life Committee and Right to Life Kentucky Heartland will begin the installation of a memorial cemetery dedicated to aborted pre-born children. The 2,000 crosses to be installed, will represent the 60,000,000 million plus children lost to abortion, since the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision on Jan 22, 1973.

Many, from surrounding communities, and other states, have responded in different ways to the memorial cemeteries. Some have attach names, prayers and special messages to the departed souls on the crosses. Others have expressed discontent and sorrow that our nation has succumbed to a Culture of Death. In truth, many hearts do weep, because countless numbers of America's children are 'no more.' **Many workers will be needed to create this memorial of tears.** The installation site will be on the Godfrey property, corner of Ring and Pear Orchard Roads, E-town. Bring a rubber mallet and join this physical and profoundly spiritual endeavor.


