REFLECTION. Amy Barrett was recently confirmed as a Judge on the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 7th Circuit in Chicago. During her confirmation hearings she spoke glowingly of her husband and 7 children. She also testified she was a graduate of Notre Dame law school. During the hearings for the seat on the 7th Circuit of Appeals Senator Diane Feinstein opined that, "Her (Amy Barrett) religious dogma lives loudly within you, and that is of concern to many people."

On Jan 16, 2019 the U.S. Senate unanimously passed a symbolic resolution disavowing opposition to federal appointees on the basis of their membership in the organization of Catholic men known as the Knights of Columbus. Senators Mazie Hirono and Kamala Harris questioned judicial nominee Brian Buescher on his membership in the Knights of Columbus, particularly its "extreme positions" such as opposing abortion and "same sex" marriage.

The position of the three Senators, on the matter of deeply held religious beliefs, would most certainly seem to be a violation of the 1st amendment to the Constitution.


