

Above all, the common outcry, which is justly made on human rights – for example, the right to health, home, work, family, culture - is false and illusory if



the right to life, the most basic and fundamental right and the condition for all other personal rights is not defended with maximum determination. St. John Paul II

REFLECTINON. Fearing a Supreme Court that may no longer be with them and a wave of pro-life laws that could force a new referendum on *Roe v. Wade*, numerous pro-abortion states are moving to formally codify a "right" to an abortion within their borders, ensuring the practice would remain legal regardless of future judicial developments.

Massachusetts – An abortion bill has been introduced that would allow late term abortions for fetal abnormalities and remove parental or judicial consent for minors requesting abortions.

New York – Under the strict avid tutelage of Governor Andrew Cuomo, New York has recently enacted a law declaring a "fundamental right" to an abortion. That means abortion would be legal anytime during the pregnancy, and up to and during the birth of the child.

<u>Vermont</u> – Abortion activists are pushing both legislation and a state constitutional amendment that would enact the same abortion law that was enacted by New York.

<u>Rhode Island</u> - Politicians have introduced two versions of a bill to codify *Roe v. Wade*. The law would also remove old abortion laws including an affirmation that life begins at conception.

<u>New Mexico</u> – The state's Public Affairs Committee voted to remove the pre-Roe v. Wade abortion ban and the right of hospital employees to refuse to participate in abortions.
