REFLECTION. The Albany Times Union reported on January 22, 2019 (sad anniversary date of the Supreme Courts abortion decisions) both chambers of the New York Legislature voted to pass legislation that would enshrine a fundamental right to abortion in the state of New York up to the birth of the child. The law declares, "Every individual that becomes pregnant has the fundamental right to choose to carry the pregnancy to term, to give birth to the child, or to have an abortion. The New York State Right to Life Committee avers that declaring abortion a "fundamental right" opens the door to invalidating "any limits on abortion" and "mandates every one take part in the culture of death." Other so called qualifying personnel beside doctors may also perform abortions under the new law.

New York's governor Andrew Cuomo, claims to be a Catholic, signed the approved abortion bill into law on January 22, 2019. As an act of celebration the Governor declared the World Trade Center and other landmarks in New York to have their lights displayed in pink.




