**REFLECTION** – On May 2, 2019 the National Day of  
Prayer, President Trump and HHS Secretary Alex Azar  
issued new regulations that will further protect  
conscience rights of doctors, nurses and other  
healthcare providers while serving patients.  
In lauding the new HHS regulations, the Susan B.  
Anthony List president Marjorie Dannenfelser affirmed:  
“Today President Trump and HHS Secretary Azar  
delivered an important victory for conscience rights,  
fulfilling a key promise to pro-life constituents” said SBA

health care professional should ever be forced to
