

In Faith, I believe that our successes are sometimes greater than we ever know. Take airline pilots for example. Prior to each and every flight, they perform a series of tests of their airplane's flight systems. They don't really expect to find things wrong because airliners are built and maintained to demanding standards. But, occasionally, something is found and the dreaded "return to the gate for maintenance" flight delay occurs. (I hope this doesn't bring a knowing, chagrined smile to your face.) Thankfully rare, catastrophic airplane accidents have sometimes been caused by a chain of events, each one seemingly of small consequence in itself. But, in combination, they led to an accident. Break any one of those links in the chain of events, possibly a pre-takeoff check discovering a system out of tolerance, and that accident probably would not have happened.

The point is that the pilots will never know of the accident that their careful check averted. They never know their victories because the accident never happened. They only know their defeats. So, they continue checking, knowing that somewhere along the line, their diligence may have averted an accident.

May our Lord grant us all the zeal and relentless determination to continue to stand for Life. And may we all have the Faith to know that somewhere along the way we may have saved a life.
