Our State Legislature is now in session and has several pro-life bills before it. 32 of the 60 days of this year's session are now behind us. Please learn about these bills and voice your opinion to our state legislators in Frankfort as soon as possible!

The numbers of Pro-Life Senators and Representatives currently in the Legislature offers the real possibility of even overriding a Governor's veto, if necessary. But time is of the essence! At the following link, you can learn about and follow the progress of several current bills: <https://legiscan.com/reports/vepqx1i3>

There, a Monitor Report under the moniker "Knight 24" has been established. At that link you can see a description of a few selected bills and an updated report on their progress through the legislature in Frankfort. Most of these bills directly pertain to abortion. Please take a look.

At the toll-free number provided in "step 1", a helpful operator will help you deliver a short recorded message to the proper legislators. Please take note of the "tips" published there.
