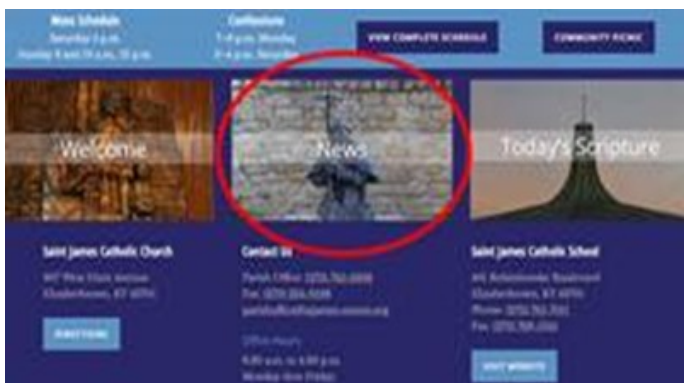

The Importance of the Family

Pope Benedict XVI called John Paul II, "the Pope of the family". He pointed out that John Paul II always emphasized that "the future of humanity passes by way of the family." Today, we often hear in the media about environmental destruction. But as John Paul II pointed out: "... we must also mention the more serious destruction of the human environment...The first and fundamental structure for "human ecology" is the family, in which man receives his first formative ideas about truth and goodness, and learns what it means to love and to be loved, and thus what it actually means to be a person. Here we mean the family founded on marriage, in which the mutual gift of self by husband and wife creates an environment in which children can be born and develop their potentialities..." Pornography, abortion and euthanasia place the family under enormous pressure in our culture. This in turn causes society to ignore and undermine the importance of marriage. Just days after the misguided California Supreme Court legalized same-sex marriage, Pope Benedict spoke out on this subject: "The union of love, based on matrimony between a man and a woman, which makes up the family, represents a good for all society that cannot be substituted by, confused with, or compared to other types of unions." La Importancia de la Familia El Papa Benedicto XVI llamaba a Juan Pablo II, "el Papa de la familia". El resaltaba que Juan Pablo II siempre enfatizaba que "el futuro de la humanidad pasa por la vía de la familia". Hoy, escuchamos frecuentemente en los medios acerca de la destrucción del medio ambiente. Pero como Juan Pablo II señaló: "... nosotros debemos mencionar la destrucción más grave del entorno humano... La estructura fundamental y principal de la "ecología humana" es la familia, en la cual el hombre recibe sus primeras ideas de formación acerca de la verdad y la bondad, y aprende que significa amar y ser amado, igualmente aprende lo que realmente significa ser una persona. Aquí nosotros entendemos la familia fundamentada en el matrimonio, en el cual la entrega mutua del esposo y la esposa crea un ambiente en el cual los hijos pueden nacer y desarrollar sus potencialidades..." Pornografía, aborto y eutanasia colocan a la familia bajo una enorme presión en nuestra cultura.

Esto causa que la sociedad ignore y subestime la importancia del matrimonio. Pocos días después de que la Corte Suprema de California equivocadamente legalizara el matrimonio del mismo sexo, el Papa Benedicto habló al respecto: "La unión de amor, basada en el matrimonio entre un hombre y una mujer, la cual constituye la familia, representa un bien para toda la sociedad que no puede ser sustituido por, confundido con, o comparado a otros tipos de uniones." Donations are eligible for the Endow Ky Tax Credit, which allows donors to receive a charitable deduction and 20 percent credit against state income taxes, up to \$10,000.

“We were glad to work with a donor to establish an endowment fund for Saint James Catholic Church, said Davette Swiney, president and CEO of CKCF. “Saint James has a long history in our community and the Saint James Catholic Church Endowment Fund offers great opportunities for individuals to help ensure support is there for the church long into the future. This fund will benefit Saint James forever.”

“Stewardship is a way of life for many parishioners and, as good stewards, each of us plays an important role in perpetuating the mission of the church,” Logsdon said. “This endowment is an opportunity to make an impactful gift to the best of one’s ability and be part of creating a sustaining revenue source for Saint James.”
