Eduquémonos en la fé

Cuaresma

La Cuaresma comienza el Miércoles de Ceniza, se extiende hasta la hora nona del Jueves Santo, lo que no incluye la Misa de la Cena del Señor. La duración de cuarenta días proviene de varias referencias bíblicas y simboliza la prueba por la que pasó Jesús al permanecer durante 40 días en el desierto de Judea, previos a su misión pública. También simbolizan los 40 días que duró el diluvio universal, además de los 40 años de la marcha del pueblo israelita por el desierto, las 40 décadas que duró la esclavitud de los hebreos en Egipto y los 40 días que pasó Moisés en el Sinaí.

La temporada de la Cuaresma se trata sobre renovación y conversión para aquellos de nosotros que ya somos Cristianos, y se trata de dar la bienvenida a nuevos Cristianos a la iglesia a través de los sacramentos de la Pascua. La Cuaresma es un tiempo para que seamos renovados espiritualmente y para enfocarnos de nuevo como Cristianos y Católicos. Veo a estas seis semanas anteriores a la Pascua como una gran oportunidad para que Dios derrame sobre nosotros su gracia y amor y para que hable a nuestros corazones. ☒ Uno de los retos para nosotros es que estamos muy ocupados. Muchos de nosotros hemos comenzado a ver la Cuaresma como otra carga, o algo más que tenemos que hacer. Sin embargo, la Cuaresma es un tiempo para examinar nuestros corazones y para permitir que Dios nos toque y nos transforme. La Cuaresma nos prepara para entrar al gran misterio de la vida, la muerte y la resurrección de nuestro Salvador, Jesucristo. Al hacerlo así, Dios desea hacernos más como su hijo, para que podamos experimentar su gracia y su vida más plenamente. Los tres pilares de la Cuaresma son la oración, el ayuno y el dar limosna o caridad. Jesús discute éstos tres pilares en la lectura del Evangelio de Mateo el cual escuchamos durante el Miércoles de Ceniza. Ayunar, orar y dar limosna son las maneras en las cuales Dios trabaja en nuestros corazones para convertirnos. Todos los tres se complementan uno a otro y son necesarios para experimentar verdaderamente las bendiciones de la Cuaresma.

Building the Culture of Life, which is the irrevocable and fundamental commitment of the Church, is a matter of proclaiming, in word and deed, the victory that has already been won in Christ and applying it to every sector of society. "Death is swallowed up in victory," as the second reading declares. That is the starting point for the Church and the pro-life movement. If death is swallowed up in victory, then so is abortion.

This victory changes the way we respond to the gift of human life. We proclaim the victory of life and we work to defend it from the lingering destructive effects of the kingdom of death. We do so not only in action but also in speech. The first reading and the Gospel today reveal the power of words. They are a revelation of the heart, of the person and they have a profound impact on others. In the Culture of Life, we respect and exalt life in the way that we speak about it. We use words that welcome the burdensome. We use words that reflect that our hearts are with the children and with the weak and defenseless. It is a language of affirmation.

When people are oppressed, the oppressor uses language of degradation, of dehumanization. This has been true throughout history, as we see in the Holocaust, and it is true regarding abortion. The unborn are called "tissue," "parasites," "waste," and other degrading words. But they are our brothers and sisters, creatures of God, equal in their human rights and dignity. They are a blessing entrusted to us. Our language, revealing our hearts, is to reflect this day by day and thereby help to change the world.

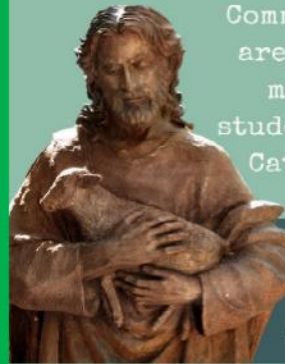

  - Each day at breakfast, each person will draw a slip of paper that has a sacrifice on it.
- Pray Lenten devotionals together each day as a family.
- Go to confession as a family.
- Pick a neighbor, family member, or friend to "adopt" this Lent. Bring them a meal or do something for them.
- Pray the Stations of the Cross on Fridays either at home or with the parish.
- Encourage better attention during Mass by assigning each member of the family 1 reading to pay special attention to (first reading, Psalm, second reading, and the Gospel). Have everyone give a re-cap of "their" reading on the way home in the car. Have a family discussion if anyone had thoughts about the readings.

**2022 PTPA – ST. JAMES HAITI COMMITTEE \*UPDATE\***  
**Sister Parish, St. Marc, St. Marc, Haiti**

**For our new parishioners:** The city of St. Marc is on the western coast, approximately sixty miles north of Port Au Prince. With God's blessing, our St. James parish twinning activity with St. Marc parish has endured since 1991. Through the love, compassion, and generosity of our St. James parishioners during these past years many basic needs have been met: a water purification system, bathrooms for the church, a large generator, renovations of both St. Marc Church and their 18<sup>th</sup> century rectory. For a number of years, we lent support to the Primary School, two Home Economics classes and with our support a Technology School has been built. It opened in 2018 with seventy-five students. Enrollment has continued. The Archbishop has assigned a priest as director of the school. During 2021, we participated in a matching funds program by Food For The Poor, through PTPA \$4,000.00 worth of rice and beans were provided St. Marc at a cost to us of \$2,000.00.

**Other assistance of major importance** are the salaries for catechists who take the Word of God to the many chapels of St. Marc. We helped to provide a radio station where the rosary is said daily and St. Marc parish can stay in contact with those whom the clergy can physically reach only one a month. We were able, with the people doing the work, to assist in taking the parishioners of Barbe Chapel from a dirt floor and leaking tin roof structure to a decent place of worship and in past years assisted in the building of one other chapel.

**Everyone ~ Thank you for your monthly donations:** They sustain our quarterly donation to our sister parish and St. Marc Tech School. Because of good communication with St. Marc's pastor, Fr. Venel Suffrard, we are able to know of the help with special needs of the parish. Recently we have received a request for EDH clean energy batteries and solar panels which provide huge savings to the parish. The current batteries are four years old and failing. Also, the cost of fuel has increased 100%.

**PTPA (Parish Twinning of the America's)** requires a twinned parish to submit a quarterly report to both the PTPA Office and their U.S. twinned parish. The report is to list how donated money has been spent for the needs of the parish, including aid to the poorest of the poor who come in need of help.

**We make annual shipments to St. Marc** through PTPA. Our collection period this year is from **March 2 to April 6**. Our storage space is now on church property.

**Call Lois Shinkle 270-765-7559** to arrange drop-offs. **Do not leave items in the church!!! Donations may also be dropped off at the Shinkle's** (621 Cherrywood Drive, Elizabethtown). Call ahead (cell 270-317-3277). If necessary, you may leave items in their carport. They will not be out of town.

**Please consider a monetary donation:** Your Haiti Committee purchases special items that have not or cannot be donated. Also, there are the shipping costs that increase each year. Transporting our shipment to the PTPA rented warehouse space in Nashville has been faithfully donated by Nall's Specialize Hauling, a much-appreciated savings.

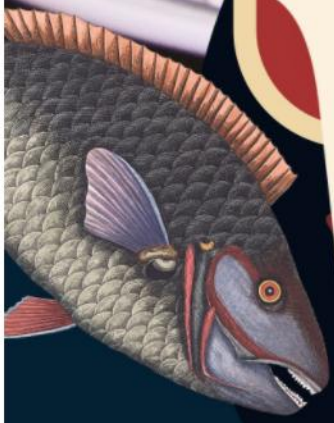

**Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** are obligatory days of *fasting and abstinence* for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of *abstinence*.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.
