Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma La oración

Durante este tiempo de Cuaresma la Iglesia nos propone algunos caminos necesarios para preparar nuestro corazón a la Pascua y son especialmente tres: el ayuno, la oración y la limosna.

La oración nos vuelve a Dios, el ayuno nos libera de una excesiva cautividad del mundo, la limosna nos vuelve más al prójimo.

No hay que olvidar que la Cuaresma nos hace acompañar cuarenta días a Jesús en el desierto, totalmente distanciado del mundo, y dedicado en absoluto a la oración y al ayuno. También podemos ver como Moisés, durante cuarenta días y cuarenta noches, se prepara en el Sinaí, en soledad, oración y ayuno, para recibir los diez mandamentos. Cuarenta años de travesía por el desierto dedica Israel para salir de Egipto y entrar en la Tierra prometida. De las tres acciones señaladas es la oración, sin duda, la que por gracia de Dios más fuerza tiene para convertirnos a Él.

La oración lo que hace es ponernos en el centro de nuestra vida a Dios. Encontrarnos con él, adorarlo, alabarlo y imitarlo. Cuando nos vean a nosotros actuar, vean al mismo Cristo. Esa oración es el camino al discipulado. Podemos acercarnos a los demás y a Dios con esa imitación perfecta de Jesucristo.

La oración, el espacio de silencio ante Dios, es un elemento decisivo para reforzar por dentro la fe y la vida cristiana. Habría que buscar, en esta Cuaresma, momentos para hacer presente ante el Señor nuestras ansias y esperanzas de cada día, nuestra petición de ayuda y de perdón, nuestro deseo de fidelidad al Evangelio. Dependerá de las posibilidades de tiempo y de tranquilidad de cada uno, pero en cualquier caso habría que esforzarse por encontrar esos espacios.

Otra forma muy útil de oración consiste en la lectura de los evangelios, o de los salmos. Eso también dependerá, claro está, de las posibilidades de cada uno. Pero, por ejemplo, uno podría proponerse leer durante esta Cuaresma el evangelio de Marcos: se trata de un texto fácil de leer y constituye un buen acercamiento a la persona de Jesús. Finalmente, otro buen propósito para este tiempo sería la participación en la Eucaristía diaria.





Saint James PTO is offering a \$1,000 scholarship to a deserving high school graduate planning to attend an insti-




