

PARISH LIFE



Pro-Peace and Pro-Life

“On receiving the Nobel Prize for Peace, Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta had the courage to say to the leaders of political communities: ‘If we let a mother kill the fruit of her womb, what is left to us? It is the principle of abortion that endangers peace in the world’. It is true! There can be no true peace without respect for life, especially if it is innocent and defenseless as is that of the unborn child. Elementary coherence requires those who seek peace to safeguard life. No pro-peace activity can be effective unless attacks on life at all its stages, from conception until natural death, are as energetically opposed.” (St. John Paul II To The Members Of The Italian Pro-Life Movement, 22 May 2003)

Today’s readings make it clear that Jesus’ resurrection does not only bring life to him. Rather, it begins a process whereby, through our obedience, life comes to us and extends through us to all the world. In the first reading, the apostles obey the Risen Lord rather than the misguided commands of human authority. More fundamentally, they point out that obedience to the Lord yields the fruit of the Holy Spirit, who gives life to all through repentance and faith.

This overarching theme of obedience that leads to life contrasts powerfully with the attitude of the culture of death that real freedom consists in forging our own way through life, insisting on our own choices, and arranging both our private lives and public policies in such a way that protects absolute, or nearly-absolute, personal autonomy. That is simply not the way of salvation or even of earthly happiness. Instead, the only way to both is a resounding “Yes” to life, in obedience to the one who conquers death and gives life abundantly. ~ Excerpts from Priests for Life

Tercer Domingo de Pascua

Jesús sale al encuentro: Pero también en esas circunstancias el Maestro está cerca. Se acerca silencioso, sin llamar la atención, pero con una estrategia muy bien pensada. No le gusta actuar con rayos y truenos, como un famoso de esta tierra, sino que está presente en la suave brisa, como nos narra el profeta Isaías. En esta ocasión, se cruza en el camino de los apóstoles con una inocente pregunta: ¿Tenéis pescado? Nada más normal que preguntar a unos pescadores si habían cogido algo. Pedro y los suyos estaban de mal humor: habían pasado toda la noche pescando, y ellos, expertos pescadores, no habían conseguido nada de nada. Responden con un seco «No», y el desconocido actúa: «Echad las redes a la derecha y hallaréis». Juan, el discípulo más joven y de corazón más limpio, reconoce rápido al desconocido: «Es el Señor». Y Pedro, tan impulsivo como siempre, se tira al agua para llegar lo antes posible junto a Él. Los apóstoles traen la gran pesca que han conseguido y junto con el Maestro empiezan a desayunar. Nadie pregunta al desconocido quién es, pues todos lo saben. Simplemente disfrutaban de su compañía, se alegran de estar nuevamente junto a Él. Pero Jesús había venido a buscar y a fortalecer sobre todo a Pedro. Cuando han terminado de comer, se lo lleva aparte y le pregunta: «¿Me amas?». ¡Vaya pregunta! ¡Sí, te amo! Pedro no sabe qué responder: le ama sinceramente, desde lo más hondo de su corazón, pero a la vez recuerda que le ha negado tres veces. ¡Cuántas veces nos sucede lo mismo! Amamos a Jesús, queremos seguirle con generosidad, pero... Si alguien nos pregunta, no dudamos en decir que somos católicos, pero constatamos que fácilmente no obramos como tales. Es la profunda contradicción que experimentaba san Pablo: No hago el bien que quiero, y sin embargo obro el mal que no quiero. Conscientes de nuestra debilidad demos a Cristo la mejor respuesta, la respuesta final de Pedro: «Tú lo sabes todo; Tú sabes que te amo».

Propósito: Consciente de mi debilidad, repetiré en mi oración la respuesta humilde de Pedro: «Señor, Tú lo sabes todo, Tú sabes que te amo». Jesús quiere que nos fortalezcamos participando de la Eucaristía y para ello confesarnos a menudo para poder estar en gracia. Así es que Dios nos fortalece para seguir nuestro camino aquí en la tierra de la mano de El, con ansias de llegar a tener vida eterna como Él nos prometió.



Financial Update for the nine months ended March 31, 2022

We would like to thank everyone for your service to St. James Parish! We have completed nine months of our fiscal year with a cash flow surplus of \$820,712, which is an increase of \$129,439 from \$691,274 a year ago. The Parish debt was \$6.0 million on March 31, 2022, compared to \$6.3 million from March 31, 2021.

Total Receipts were \$4.1 million for the nine months ended March 31, 2022, an increase of \$575,164 from \$3.5 million for the nine months ended March 31, 2021. Net Collections were \$1.8 million for the first nine months of this fiscal year, an increase of \$306,872 from the same time last year. We are fortunate to be able to celebrate Mass in person compared to the COVID period impacting March of 2021, which contributed to the increase in collections for 2022. For 2021, the Parish received \$439,300 from the Payroll Protection Program Grant which helped the parish during 2021. For 2022, we received grant income for the Pre-School of \$247,212 related to additional governmental stimulus measures. Tuition and School Income increased \$372,788 from the prior year primarily due to the increase in enrollment. Other receipts increased \$115,792 largely from a \$114,349 Bequest to St. James received during 2022.

Total Parish Expenses were \$3.2 million for the first nine months ended March 31, 2022, which represents an increase of \$473,926 from \$2.8 million for the same period a year ago. Debt service represented \$286,593 of the increase from the prior year along with an increase in payroll expense for the period ended March 31, 2022. The parish and school staff did not receive a payroll increase for the prior year.

The Parish had two recent foundations established by parishioners to help build support for the future. The first was an endowment for St. James Parish. This endowment is available for all parishioners and is particularly useful for legacy gifts as you are doing your Estate Planning. Several significant gifts have already been contributed to this endowment from parishioners. The second endowment is a Tuition Assistance Endowment to aid students attending St. James School. With this endowment, up to 50% of the contributions are eligible for use with current year scholarship funding at the discretion of the donor. The endowment will grow to provide solid support for providing students with a catholic education.

We made improvements to both campuses this period including a new video system at the church to support our Sunday Mass recordings for parishioners who need to view Mass at home. We are replacing two more of the HVAC units at the Church. This will complete the process of upgrading the HVAC units which includes three units completed in the prior year. With the assistance of gifts from two parishioners along with funds from the Parish Picnic, a fryer trailer was purchased for parish events. This fryer was used for the Knights of Columbus fish fry's during Lent and will be used for the Parish Picnic. We have replaced and will continue replacing technology, including computer and Chrome book upgrades at the school on a scheduled process. One of the more financially significant projects recently completed and implemented was comprehensive compensation study for teachers and staff of St. James School. We need to ensure we still are competitive in attracting and retaining top educators for our school. This will result in an increase in compensation expense for the current fiscal year and into the next fiscal year.

We certainly had a positive nine months of the current fiscal year so far financially for the Parish due to everyone's generosity. We pray the Holy Spirit continues to guide us as we move forward together!
