Décimo Séptimo Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

Y cuando añadimos: Venga a nosotros tu reino, lo que pedimos es que crezca nuestro deseo de que este reino llegue a nosotros y de que nosotros podamos reinar en él, pues el reino de Dios vendrá ciertamente, lo queramos o no.

Cuando decimos: Hágase tu voluntad así en la tierra como en el cielo, pedimos que el Señor nos otorgue la virtud de la obediencia, para que así cumplamos su voluntad como la cumplen sus ángeles en el cielo.

Cuando decimos: El pan nuestro de cada día dánosle hoy, con el hoy queremos significar el tiempo presente, para el cual, al pedir el alimento principal, pedimos ya lo suficiente, pues con la palabra pan significamos todo cuanto necesitamos, incluso el sacramento de los fieles, el cual nos es necesario en esta vida temporal, aunque no sea para alimentarla, sino para conseguir la vida eterna.

Cuando decimos: Perdónanos nuestras deudas, así como nosotros perdonamos a nuestros deudores, nos obligamos a pensar tanto en lo que pedimos como en lo que debemos hacer, no sea que seamos indignos de alcanzar aquello por lo que oramos.

Cuando decimos: No nos dejes caer en la tentación, nos exhortamos a pedir la ayuda de Dios, no sea que, privados de ella, nos sobrevenga la tentación y consintamos ante la seducción o cedamos ante la aflicción.

Cuando decimos: Líbranos del mal, recapacitamos que aún no estamos en aquel sumo bien en donde no será posible que nos sobrevenga mal alguno. Y estas últimas palabras de la oración dominical abarcan tanto, que el cristiano, sea cual fuere la tribulación en que se encuentre, tiene en esta petición su modo de gemir, su manera de llorar, las palabras con que empezar su oración, la reflexión en la cual meditar y las expresiones con que terminar dicha oración. Es, pues, muy conveniente valerse de estas palabras para grabar en nuestra memoria todas estas realidades.

Porque todas las demás palabras que podamos decir, bien sea antes de la oración, para excitar nuestro amor y para adquirir conciencia clara de lo que vamos a pedir, bien sea en la misma oración, para acrecentar su intensidad, no dicen otra cosa que lo que ya se contiene en la oración dominical, si hacemos la oración de modo conveniente. Y quien en la oración dice algo que no puede referirse a esta oración evangélica, si no ora ilícitamente, por lo menos hay que decir que ora de una manera carnal. Aunque no sé hasta qué punto puede llamarse lícita una tal oración, pues a los renacidos en el Espíritu solamente les conviene orar con una oración espiritual.



**LETTER FROM THE PASTOR**

Dear St. James Parishioners,

Blessings to you all. A month has now passed since I left St. James for chaplain training at Fort Jackson. One month from now I will gratefully be back in your midst. Just before my departure we honored the life and death of long-time parishioner James "Jim" H. Brown. Jim's legacy reached beyond St. James to impact our local community and the Archdiocese of Louisville as well. In 1960 Jim began teaching at his alma mater Elizabethtown Catholic High School, eventually becoming Principal in 1967. In 1970 Jim became Principal of St. James Catholic School and continued in this role until 1987.

Before his death, I began conversation with Jim's family about an appropriate way to honor his outstanding service to Catholic education at St. James over 25 years. A proposal was made to the family to consider naming the street on the school campus leading from Robinbrooke in his honor and Jim was notified shortly before his passing.

At our school Mass on Wednesday, August 24th the street sign will be blessed with our school students as well as friends and family members of Jim. The sign will be installed before we gather for our parish picnic on Saturday, August 27th.

I am very grateful to Fr. Loi, the newly assigned Fr. Jean and St. James staff for their service during my time away. Please know of my continued prayers for you. I look forward to returning to St. James in good time. Peace be with you all.


