HISPANIC MINISTRY

XXXII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Jesucristo es el primogénito de los muertos; a él sea dada la gloria y el poder por siempre.
Lucas 20: 27-38



Nos encontramos en el evangelio una situación parecida a la que sucede en nuestro tiempo, muchas personas que no creen intentan desprestigiar la vida de Jesús y también a los que nos llamamos cristianos.

Muchos al igual que los saduceos nos mofamos de la resurrección, otros creemos que en la resurrección nos veremos y conoceremos. Pero lo realmente importante es que nos encontraremos con Dios y viviremos con Él. Jesús siempre es claro en sus planteamientos, no miente, no quiere que creamos cosas que no son. Jamás deja sin respuesta a quién se la plantea.

En ningún momento del evangelio Jesús habla de la resurrección como una continuidad de esta vida que ahora disfrutamos. La Resurrección es otra cosa, es vivir en la plenitud del Padre y junto a Él. Aunque es muy sobrio en este tema deja claro que Dios no es un Dios de muerto, sino un Dios de vivos, porque es la fuente inagotable de amor y vida.

La Iglesia como siempre dedica el día 2 a los difuntos y siempre nos recuerda que la esperanza y la misericordia de Dios es tan grande que todos somos acogidos con amor.

La fe es importante para creer en la resurrección, porque la resurrección es el pilar de la vida cristiana, así lo afirma San Juan en su evangelio: Yo soy la resurrección y la vida; el que cree en mí, aunque muera, vivirá.

This year's effort was especially difficult because of the lack of rain and the resulting extremely hard, dry condition of the soil. Only the amazing, resolute determination of all our volunteers enabled us to successfully complete the task that day! We are enormously proud to be associated with each and every one of you!

Please vote YES for Life, Kentucky's Constitutional Amendment # 2 on Tuesday's election ballot. It will be the very last item on, possibly on the back of, your ballot.

It is not part of any straight party ticket vote. You must additionally vote explicitly for it at the end of your ballot. Please remember that the only words added to the Kentucky State Constitution by the passage of Amendment # 2 are:

"To protect human life, nothing in this Constitution shall be construed to secure or protect a right to abortion or require the funding of abortion."

It does not change existing law of abortion. It only prevents Courts and activist pro-abortion judges from changing the law themselves.

Proposed New Section (1) The General Assembly, in odd-numbered years, shall convene in regular session on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in January for the purpose of electing legislative leaders, adopting rules of procedure, organizing committees, and introducing and considering legislation. (2) No regular session of the General Assembly occurring in odd-numbered years shall continue beyond thirty legislative days. (3) No bill raising revenue or appropriating funds shall be passed by the General Assembly in a regular session in an odd-numbered year unless it shall be agreed upon by three-fifths of all the members elected to each House. (4) The General Assembly, in even-numbered years, shall convene in regular session on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in January, and no regular session of the General Assembly in even-numbered years shall extend beyond sixty legislative days. (5) Except as otherwise provided in this Constitution, the General Assembly shall establish by general law or joint resolution the date the regular session shall end. No bill establishing a later date shall be passed by the General Assembly unless it shall be agreed upon by three-fifths of all the members elected to each House. No session of the General Assembly shall extend beyond December 31. (6) In addition to a regular session, the General Assembly may be convened by Joint Proclamation of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for no more than twelve legislative days annually, during which the General Assembly may recess from time to time as it determines necessary. Should a vacancy occur in the office of the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Joint Proclamation for the House with the vacancy may be issued by the Senate</p>

Saint Vincent de Paul Outreach Annual Report From 1 October 2021 through 30 September 2022

The resources used by the Outreach to assist the less fortunate in Elizabethtown and southern Hardin Co. are received from our Saint James family through your donations of food and funds as well as profits gained from shopping at the local Saint Vincent DePaul store. Thank you for your amazing generosity and for "helping us help others". Through these donations we were able to provide the following assistance:

FOOD: \$73,201 (estimated retail value of food distributed); 1,348 households assisted with 2,360 individuals assisted within these households.

UTILITIES: \$56,242; 349 households assisted with 700 individuals assisted within these households.

HOUSING (rent and motel): \$24,454; 152 households assisted with 265 individuals assisted within these households.

OTHER (bus tickets, gasoline; prescriptions): \$5,861*; 489 households assisted with 928 individuals assisted within these households.

TOTAL ASSISTANCE: \$159,758 expended to help 2,338 households with 4,253 individuals assisted within these households.

*Total includes \$5,400 for a twin (sharing of financial resources) between SVDP Elizabethtown and SVDP Owensboro to help with the violent, devastating tornadoes that struck western Kentucky December 10, 2021.
