PARISH LIFE



It would be hard to find a set of readings more appropriate for comment on pro-life themes than those of this weekend. The Beatitudes (Gospel) are all about turning upside-down the way the world evaluates who is important and worthy of attention. The Lord and the Church point us to “those who count for nothing” (Second Reading) in the eyes of the world as those specially favored by God. When the Beatitudes speak of the “poor,” they do not only mean those who are materially deprived. Scripture refers to the “poor” as those who are completely dependent upon God, those who have no worldly help, those who have been marginalized.

The unborn are the poorest of the poor. In the eyes of so many in the world, and in the eyes of the law, they “count for nothing”. They have little or no defense. They are the ones, above all, to whom the words of today’s responsorial psalm can be applied: “The Lord...secures justice for the oppressed; the Lord sets captives free... and raises up those that were bowed down.”

The Lord does this, of course, through his people, who, as the Beatitudes say, “are sorrowing” (because they weep over the injustices of the world, like abortion); “hunger and thirst for justice” (to see the rights of all respected); “show mercy” (particularly to those in danger of death); are “peacemakers” (for, as Mother Teresa said, the greatest destroyer of peace is abortion); and “are insulted and persecuted for my sake” (as many pro-life activists are).

The Lord secures justice, as the psalm says. Therefore, Zephaniah urges the Lord’s people, “seek justice,” and the Beatitudes declare that those who do so are blessed. To be like God we must do the works of God. Today let us call God’s people to active involvement in the pro-life cause. ~ Priests for Life

Stewardship Story



Our names are Jessa and Abby Gilland and we are 6th grade students at St. James School. We have been attending St. James Catholic Church since we were babies. St. James is like home to us and we have learned so much about our Catholic faith and what it means to be a good steward of all the gifts God has given us. We have learned by attending Mass and by attending a Catholic school, but we have also learned by the wonderful examples of our Catholic Community at St. James.

One of the ways we share our gifts is by altar serving. We love altar serving because it makes us feel closer to Jesus. We feel so close to the miracle of the Eucharist. We know Catholics are the only Christians who believe that Jesus is present, body, blood, soul and divinity, in the Eucharist and during Mass we pray that everyone can have faith and believe so they can also experience this beautiful gift Jesus has given us. We have learned in our Theology class that this activity can be linked to the spiritual work of mercy, praying for the living and the dead.

We also serve at Family Faith Formation in the child care room. We help keep the children 3 and under entertained. We love little children and we think they love us too! We see God in all their little faces and they bring us joy. When they are upset, we comfort them. We play games with them and make them laugh. We do this so their parents can have time to go to class and learn more about God and their Catholic faith. Their parents really seem to appreciate it and it makes them happy that their children are enjoying themselves too!

One more way we serve is by volunteering at the Room in the Inn on the first Wednesday of the month during the months of December, January and February. This is a very important ministry because area churches work together to provide shelter for the homeless during these very cold months. We visit with the guests and play board games. Sometimes we will also help serve refreshments or fold linens. Volunteering in this ministry was a little scary at first because we didn't know what to expect, but we learned that we are helping to comfort people who have fallen on hard times and who just need a little help. We have met some very nice people and it feels good showing them there are people who care about them. This is a great way to share your "love of neighbor"!

Being involved in stewardship has taught us that everyone, even children, have been given gifts by God that can be shared. What we have also learned is that when we share our gifts with others, we receive gifts in return.
