**Pope Benedict's Encyclical
"God is Love"**

Pope Benedict XVI says the following words in his first encyclical letter "God is Love": "In sacramental communion I become one with the Lord, like all the other communicants. As Saint Paul says, "Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread" (1 Cor 10:17). Union with Christ is also union with all those to whom he gives himself. I cannot possess Christ just for myself; I can belong to him only in union with all those who have become, or who will become, his own. ... Love of God and love of neighbour are now truly united: God incarnate draws us all to himself. ... Here the usual contraposition between worship and ethics simply falls apart. "Worship" itself, Eucharistic communion, includes the reality both of being loved and of loving others in turn. A Eucharist which does not pass over into the concrete practice of love is intrinsically fragmented" (n. 14). These words remind us of our calling to love all our neighbors, born and unborn.

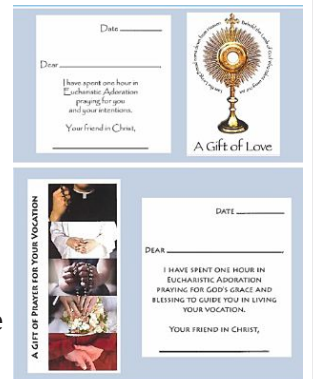

Some years ago we were introduced to the members of a French family. The name of one son was "Dieudonné". Derived from Dieu a donné, in English this name beautifully translates to: "Gift of God" or "God-given".

This wonderful sentiment applies to so much in our lives; our parents, each other, our family, our Catholic faith, our Life, Liberty and the Freedom to pursue our happiness in the way we see fit. Gratitude to God for all these things and the desire that every child conceived have the same opportunities we have had motivates us in the Pro-Life effort.

The Saint James Respect Life Committee, to which we belong, raises funds to support the vital, local mission of the Clarity Solutions pregnancy center. The Committee also participates in Right to Life Kentucky Heartland Association activities, an organization to which we also belong. Probably the most locally visible activity of our committee's participation is that organization's "Cemetery of the Innocents" which can be seen every year during November at the intersection of Ring Road and Pear Orchard Road on the Godfrey's property. The 3,000+ crosses there are intended to remind passers-by of the astonishing, approximate daily number of abortions that take place in our precious United States of America every day. We are humbled, but inspired by the hard working volunteers of St. James and the other local church groups of all denominations who show up each year to make this display happen!

We accept that we will never know, in this life, if our efforts have been successful in deterring abortions. But, in our hearts we believe that through the Respect Life Committee of St. James we can continue to inform our congregation in the hope that we will once again be a nation of faith that espouses a Culture of Life and protects the unborn.

February 22, 2023 is Ash Wednesday this year.

That is an obligatory day of *fasting and abstinence* for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of *abstinence*.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.
