PARISH LIFE



The exodus was not easy for God's people, nor was the passion easy for Christ. Yet these were the paths to the destruction of death and the revelation of life. So it is for us, who – as individuals and as a society – are called to make the transition from a culture of death to a culture of life. It is like what Abram is asked to do in the first reading – to leave all that is familiar, comfortable, and predictable, and to set out for “a land that I will show you.” ... People wonder what changes will occur in society when so many children, now being aborted, are born instead. “Will society be able to handle the change?” is the question they ask.

And, of course, the question of how to handle the change is also asked on a very personal and individual level by the pregnant mother who is not sure she can continue the pregnancy.

It is Abram being asked to leave the comfortable and familiar and set out for a whole new land, a new way of life, and a new fruitfulness. It is the People of God at the edge of the Red Sea, wondering how it can open. It is the apostles on the Mount of the Transfiguration, wondering what this vision means, and what it means “to rise from the dead.” The message for God's people today is that we are to move forward into the frightening and unfamiliar changes that are required for those committed to doing what is right. ~ Priests for Life.

En el esplendor de la nube se oyó la voz del Padre, que decía: “Éste es mi Hijo amado; escúchenlo”.

En el día de hoy, según el Calendario Romano corresponde la celebración de la Fiesta de la Transfiguración del Señor. Esta potente Teofanía y Cristofanía (manifestación de Dios y de Cristo) acontece en una montaña (Monte Tabor dice la tradición), esto tiene importancia porque en la Biblia la montaña es el lugar de la revelación de Dios, lo vemos claramente en el relato del Monte Sinaí (también llamado Horeb) en el libro de Éxodo. Al hermoso monte Tabor Jesús sube acompañado de su círculo más cercano (Pedro, Santiago y Juan), ellos serán testigos privilegiados de su momento más glorioso (Transfiguración) y también de su momento más humillante en la agonía de Getsemaní (otro Monte). Stewardship Story

While I am not a life-long member of St James, I have been one for sixty-seven years. My family moved here when I was ten. I attended St James Elementary and Elizabethtown Catholic High School. Along with my parents, the nuns and priests laid a solid foundation for what I later came to know as good stewardship. They encouraged me to give of my time, talents and treasures. They taught me that only when you give, do you receive back.

After high school, I attended WKU. During my time there, church remained an important part of my life through the Newman Club and work with Fr Ralph Beiting and the Christian Appalachian Project in Eastern Kentucky.

In 1967, I returned to Elizabethtown, married and started a family. My children attended St James Elementary. I served on the first Parish Council and as Chair from 1972-74. During that time I helped negotiate the first covenant relationship with Christ Episcopal Church. Along with my sister, Cheryl, I started helping with the Thanksgiving meal. Still today I do that in her memory, along with her granddaughters. In the past, I have been a lector, a Eucharistic Minister for the Sick and Homebound, an RCIA sponsor, and participated in Renew and Why Catholic. Now, in the twilight of my life, I am still able to be an active member of the Catholic Women Bible Study, Bereavement Committee, Forever Young, St Vincent Thrift Store, Room in the Inn, Advent by Candlelight, and I serve as a substitute money counter.

I encourage you to get involved in our church. Especially find time to do so when you are young. You will always get more than you give; the relationships you form will be everlasting. Trust in God. He will help you find a way. Remember, "not my will but Thine be done."

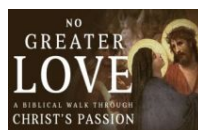
