Am I ready from this day forward to be a better prolifer? Am I ready to launch out with new strength, generosity, and determination to bring an end to abortion, without counting the cost to myself? Am I grateful enough for the gift of life to work to give life to others? Do I thank God for the privilege of being part of the pro-life movement?

Domingo de Ramos "De La Pasión Del Señor"

No podemos empezar esta reflexión sin dirigirnos directamente a Jesús, y lo vamos a hacer ya: "Jesús, quiero pedirte luz, sentimientos, sensibilidad para comprender lo

que pasaste cuando entraste triunfalmente en Jerusalén. Hoy quiero comprender el porqué de lo que hiciste y el porqué de tu llanto. Por eso te pido que sepa estar atenta y no perderme ningún momento de esta escena".

Todo el texto de hoy, con un empiece de una semana de Pasión, me lleva a verte a ti, a sentirte, a quererte, a comprenderte. ¡Qué grande eres, Señor! Me figuro la escena, y estoy ahí... y veo la multitud que alaba, que grita, con palmas, los niños... Y te veo a ti, triste, acongojado, lamentándote, sollozando y diciendo: "¡Qué pena! Si se dieran cuenta de lo que está pasando en su vida... ¡Qué pena!". Y Tú también me miras a mí v me dices lo mismo: "Si te dieras cuenta de algo..., si te dieras cuenta de todo el amor que te tengo, si te dieras cuenta de cómo estoy trabajando tu vida y de cuántas gracias y de cuántos momentos y de cuántas actitudes estoy dándote y regalándote!".

En este encuentro nos quedamos así, pensando y encontrándonos con la mirada de Jesús: Jesús mira a Jerusalén, Jesús me mira a mí. Y en silencio, ahí, en la profundidad del amor, comprendemos el llanto de Jesús, el amor enorme, y lo que me dice: que me dé cuenta, que me despierte, que no grite "¡Hosanna!" y al rato "¡Crucifícale!". Y que le puedo crucificar continuamente, con mis palabras, con mis gestos, con mis acciones. Señor, no quiero verte llorar sobre mi vida, y quiero ser humilde, buena, obediente, fiel. Haz, Señor, que mi vida no sea un llanto para ti, sino que sea una continua alabanza de tu amor y una continua alegría. Y que pueda decir "¡Hosanna, Jesús, porque me quieres! ¡Hosanna, porque me perdonas! ¡Hosanna, porque Tú eres mi Rey!". Y yo, como humilde borriquito, te llevaré en mi trono, Señor. Gracias.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.
