Politics and Religion Do Mix

The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, in its doctrinal note "On some questions regarding the participation of Catholics in political life" (2002) said about St. Thomas

More: "[He] gave witness by his martyrdom to the inalienable dignity of the human conscience. Though subjected to various forms of psychological pressure, Saint Thomas More refused to compromise, never forsaking the constant fidelity to legitimate authority and institutions which distinguished him; he taught by his life and his death that 'man cannot be separated from God, nor politics from morality'."

In relation to the Culture of Life, this weekend's readings reflect on our nature as a people, "a chosen race... a holy people." This truth is expressed by the Church in our day through Pope John Paul II's expression, "the People of Life" (Evangelium Vitae). In section 79 of that encyclical, the Pope invoked themes reminiscent of this weekend's readings and tied into the overall theme of the Easter season:

"We are the people of life because God, in his unconditional love, has given us the Gospel of life and by this same Gospel we have been transformed and saved. We have been ransomed by the "Author of life" (Acts 3:15) at the price of his precious blood (cf. 1 Cor 6:20; 7:23; 1 Pet 1:19). Through the waters of Baptism we have been made a part of him (cf. Rom 6:4-5; Col 2:12), as branches which draw nourishment and fruitfulness from the one tree (cf. Jn 15:5). Interiorly renewed by the grace of the Spirit, "who is the Lord and giver of life", we have become a people for life and we are called to act accordingly."

Moreover, the declaration of Jesus that he is "the Way, the Truth, and the Life," and his reference to the "works" that he and his people do, can be effectively summarized by saying that Jesus is the Way precisely because he is truth and life. The Son of God came into the world to destroy the works of the devil" (1 Jn. 3:8), and as John 8 reveals, those works are lies and murder. Jesus, the Way, overcomes those works precisely by being the Truth (undoing the devil's lies) and the Life (undoing the devil's works of death.)

The Church's commitment to the defense of human life, and the work of the People of Life, takes its motivation and its shape from this truth.

Jesús le dice estas palabras tan profundas: Yo soy el Camino la Verdad y la Vida nadie va al Padre si no es por mí". Jesús camino, Jesús verdad y Jesús vida.

En este día queremos pedirle al Señor que realmente podamos ser verdaderos discípulos. Que podamos descubrir en Él, este camino que nos conduce a la felicidad. La verdad que nos hace libres, como dice Jesús: "si permanecen en mí serán verdaderamente mis discípulos, conocerán la verdad y la verdad los hará libres." Y esta vida, que no es cualquier vida, la vida en abundancia que nos ofrece Jesús. Y es la abundancia que tenemos que alcanzar cada día con todo lo que nos toca realizar día a día en nuestro cotidiano andar tratando de ser cada día mejores instrumentos del Señor. Mejores discípulos. Tratando de buscar alcanzar esta promesa que el Señor nos ha realizado.

In an effort to fulfill this commitment, all employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth (18 and under) for **ANY** length of time are required to participate in one of the **Safe Environment Training Workshops**.

Saint James Catholic Church will offer a training Monday, May 15th at 6:30pm in the Batcheldor Hall.

Participants will receive a copy of the new Sexual Abuse Policies and a resource manual.

No registration is necessary. Sign-in sheets will be available at the workshops.

- Children under the age of 16 should never attend the Safe Environment Training Program (nor should anyone under the age of 18 be considered an adult or placed in unsupervised environments requiring the adult supervision of minors). Any person 18 or older who is in a supervisory role with children **MUST** have a criminal background check.
- Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the workshop in order to complete paperwork.
- **All registrants must attend, and stay for the ENTIRE 2-hour presentation, and complete participant paperwork.** Failure to do so will result in having to re-complete the course in the correct manner.
