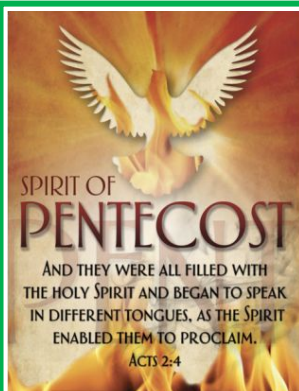

PARISH LIFE



Fifty days after the Passover, the People of Israel celebrated "Pentecost," observing the giving of the law on Mount Sinai, when God wrote the law with his own finger on the tablets of stone. The feast was originally rooted in the celebration of the harvest. It was on that Pentecost Day that the apostles reaped the harvest of the Lord's Passover of suffering, crucifixion, and resurrection, and received the Holy Spirit, who writes the law on our hearts.

This same Holy Spirit who came mightily on Pentecost comes to us. The same Spirit is in us, by our baptism and confirmation – the same Spirit who transformed the apostles, who raises the dead, and who changes bread and wine into Christ's Body and Blood. That same Spirit is in us, and this should give us tremendous confidence in following Christ.

The Holy Spirit, the "Lord and Giver of Life," brings us back to our truest selves as he illumines us regarding the sanctity of life. The Spirit brings many gifts, and one of them is to enable us to see creation in its proper relationship to God – including the crowning of his creation, the gift of human life.

When we do not have this light of the Holy Spirit, the law we have to follow seems like an imposition from the outside that limits our freedom. That's what people in the world sometimes feel about our attitude toward abortion and euthanasia. They think we are "restricting rights." But when the Holy Spirit fills us, he gives us an inner attraction to all that is right and good, so that we do not feel pushed where we would rather not go, but rather pulled by the attractiveness of what is good and right.

The Holy Spirit is also the Advocate, who pleads our cause. When he fills us, he makes us advocates for all our brothers and sisters in need, including the most vulnerable, the unborn.

Domingo de Pentecostés

Cuando los once discípulos estaban encerrados en una casa por miedo a los que habían matado al Profeta de Galilea, el Resucitado vino hasta ellos y les dijo: "¡La paz sea con ustedes!" y ellos "se alegraron de ver al Señor". Pero la paz que les traía los iba a sacar de la paz del encierro y la soledad... En seguida les dijo: "Como el Padre me envió, también yo los envío". El Resucitado los desinstala, los saca de su escondite, de su búsqueda egoísta de seguridad. La paz que el Señor nos trae, no siempre se parece a la nuestra. Casi siempre buscamos la paz encerrándonos en nosotros mismos y evitando todos los riesgos de la construcción colectiva de nuestras comunidades y de nuestra sociedad. En esto nos parecemos a los discípulos. Tenemos miedo a ser heridos y salir lastimados... Hay que reconocer que este miedo no es puro invento. Efectivamente, tenemos experiencia de haber sido heridos muchas veces en nuestras relaciones con los demás y procuramos evitar el dolor y el sufrimiento que produce este choque. Pero también sabemos que cuando nos encerramos y nos aislamos de los demás y del mundo, gozamos apenas de una paz a medias; es una paz frágil que en cualquier momento se desvanece en nuestras manos. Pero el Señor se las arregla para irrumpir en nuestro interior con el sople de su Espíritu y, aún teniendo las puertas cerradas, como los discípulos en el cenáculo, viene a inquietarnos y a salvarnos de nuestra aparente paz. Esa es la Buena nueva de hoy. Que el Señor no se cansa de entrar en nuestras vidas para ofrecernos SU paz. Una paz que nos abre a los demás con el riesgo de ser heridos. Las heridas de las manos y el costado es lo primero que les enseña el Resucitado a los discípulos cuando les anuncia su paz... Se trata, entonces, de una paz conflictiva. Es una paz que abre desde fuera nuestros sepulcros para que no sigamos viviendo como muertos, sino para que vivamos una vida plena y auténtica, es decir, llena de preguntas y de problemas, pero iluminada por Dios que es el que nos ofrece la auténtica vida en abundancia.

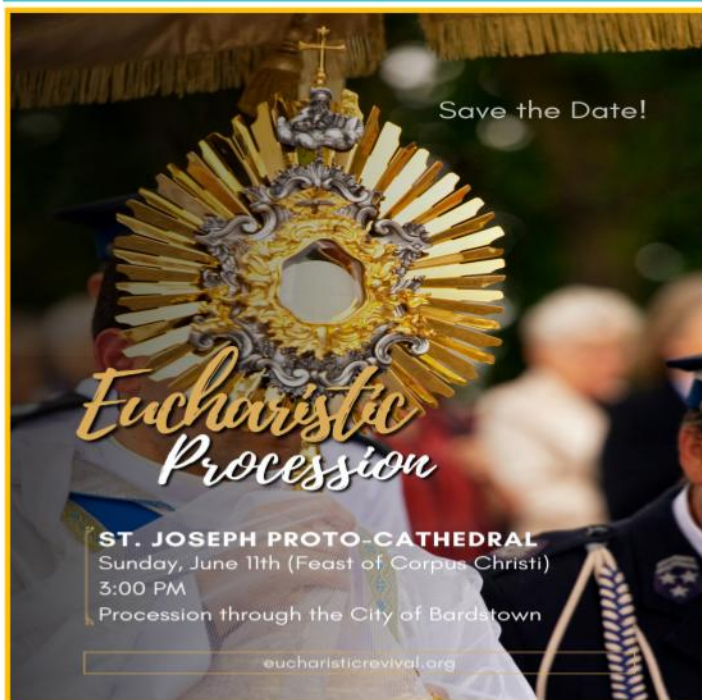
