**XV Domingo Ordinario**

En la parábola del sembrador Jesús quiere que reflexionemos, que tienen que ver con mi vida estas semillas?

Sencillamente todo. En ellas está nuestra realización personal, y la verdadera autenticidad como cristianos. Las semillas son la palabra de Dios, lo dijo Cristo; pero no sólo son la palabra de Dios sino cualquier regalo que nos hace. Lo interesante es qué hacemos con estas semillas.

Las primeras caen al borde del camino, vinieron los pájaros y se lo comieron. Esto es cuando al escuchar la palabra de Dios – que nos puede hablar de muchas maneras, por el sacerdote que nos da la homilía en la Santa misa, no le hacemos caso. Más bien hacemos caso a esas otras muchas voces y no a lo que Dios quiere de nosotros. Echamos en un saco roto la palabra y los regalos de Dios.

Las siguientes caen en terreno pedregoso. Oyes los consejos y quieres ponerlos en práctica. En tu interior ves brotar los primeros retoños de una primavera prometedor, pero el viento sopla muy fuerte. En un inicio las otras voces que te quieren alejar de Dios parecen brisas que se apagan, pero luego se levantan tornados. Viste entonces cómo las flores que se prometían nunca se abrieron, o se consumieron por el miedo a mostrar la belleza de lo que habían recibido. En ese momento se secó la planta.

Otras cayeron entre zarzas. ¿Cuáles son las zarzas en nuestra vida? Son todas aquellas seducciones que nos tiende el mundo: el dinero, las vanidades, los lujos, las comodidades superfluas, etc. La semilla es recibida por la tierra. Es una buena tierra, es una buena persona. El problema llega cuando chocan la palabra de Dios que hemos recibido y esto que se pone al alcance de la mano, lo fácil del mundo para proporcionarnos “felicidad” fácil y efímera. Hay que tener la valentía de escoger la felicidad verdadera. La palabra ilumina la conciencia y llena de vida.

Las últimas caen en tierra buena. Tierra buena es esa que ha sido abonada y preparada con antelación, haciéndose para que sea fértil. ¡Debemos ser tierra buena para la semilla del amor! Amor de Dios que se nos muestra en los hombres, en nuestros amigos, en nuestra familia. Estos son los cristianos en los que ha fructificado la palabra de Dios. Han recibido la simiente y ha dado raíces. Las raíces sólo ayudan a que la planta pueda dar dos grandes dones a quienes lo rodean: La flor y el fruto. Flor que es la alegría de sentirse regalado por Dios. Flor que es el amor a Dios. Y Fruto, que no es otra cosa sino la manifestación de ese amor en quienes nos rodean. El Cristiano auténtico es el que lo demuestra en sus obras. Es el que vive con la consciencia de que la palabra de Dios es viva y eficaz y hace que él obre según la voluntad de Dios, que lo único que busca es su felicidad.

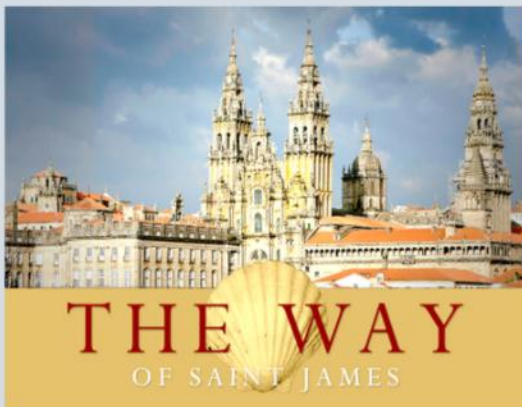
