**XVI Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario**

En el evangelio de hoy, Cristo nos habla abiertamente del combate entre el bien y el mal en nuestra vida. El misterio del mal que acompaña como sombra al bien. Al final, el bien triunfará por encima del mal pero tenemos que sacar el mayor provecho de estas enseñanzas para cuando se nos presente en nuestras vidas.

La presencia del mal es un misterio. Difícil de digerir en ocasiones, doloroso de aceptar, amargo en asimilar. Sin embargo, la explicación del mal la tenemos en la ausencia del bien; un bien que debería estar presente y que por alguna razón no lo está. En el evangelio vemos que es Dios quien siembra la semilla buena, y el enemigo siembra al lado la cizaña. Con una cercanas apreciación podemos percibir esta lucha constante en la sociedad actual, pero también en el interior de cada hombre. La lucha por ser honestos en nuestro trabajo, por no devolver ojo por ojo, sino de responder de acuerdo a los criterios del evangelio. Dios está presente en nuestras vidas sembrando la semilla buena. Se hace presente a través de su Reino.

En buena parte depende de nosotros si queremos que la cizaña irrumpa en nuestra existencia. Podemos arrancar de raíz el mal si lo descubrimos a tiempo, pero en ocasiones requiere de mucho amor a Cristo.

**Pope Benedict on Life**

“The causes that lead to such painful decisions as abortion are of course many and complex. If, on the one hand, faithful to her Lord's commandment, the Church never tires of reaffirming that the sacred value of every human being's life originates in the Creator's plan, on the other hand, she encourages the promotion of every initiative in support of women and families in order to create the favorable conditions in which to welcome life, and the protection of the family institution founded on the marriage between a man and a woman. Not only has permitting recourse to the termination of pregnancy not solved the problems that afflict many women and a fair number of families, but it has also made another wound in our society, unfortunately, already burdened by deep suffering” (Address of Pope Benedict XVI to Italy's Pro-life Movement, May 12, 2008).

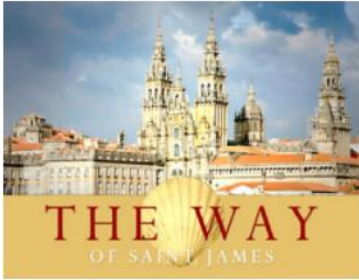
God gives time for repentance. This is a key theme of today's readings, and it can be applied to the patience that the People of Life need to have as they build a Culture of Life with painstakingly slow but steady steps. Why, some might ask, does God not just stop all the abortions today? He certainly does not justify a single one of them, nor does he allow us to justify them. Moreover, he calls us to do the most we can to restore justice today.

Yet the weeds and wheat grow together; good and evil co-exist. This generous patience of the Lord by which he allows the sinner room to find repentance has led to many conversions. The website of the Silent No More Awareness Campaign, for example, contains numerous testimonies of those who speak out about their abortion and healing ([www.SilentNoMore.com](http://www.SilentNoMore.com)). Also, many abortionists have converted and now speak out publicly about it (see [www.AbortionTestimony.com](http://www.AbortionTestimony.com)).

As we try to elect and lobby public officials, it is particularly important to emphasize the theme of patience. Weeds and wheat grow together – but they do grow. As the bishops indicate in *Living the Gospel of Life*, we are called to use our votes to advance the culture of life. Yet no candidate has a magic wand to end the culture of death.

In recognition of our patron saint's feast day on July 25, the parish will sponsor an opportunity for parishioners to help in the community:

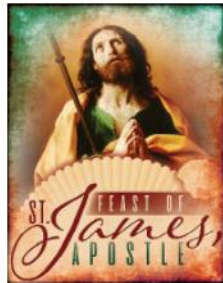


**What:** Service opportunity for adult parishioners and friends; and children 10 years and older, at Feeding America, packing food boxes for senior citizens (via an assembly line)
