"Reason alone is sufficient to recognize the inviolable value of each single human life, but if we also look at the issue from the standpoint of faith, "every violation of the personal dignity of the human being cries out in vengeance to God and is an offence against the creator of the individual" (John Paul II, Christifideles Laici, 37). Precisely because this involves the internal consistency of our message about the value of the human person, the Church cannot be expected to change her position on this question. I want to be completely honest in this regard. This is not something subject to alleged reforms or 'modernizations'" -- Pope Francis, Apostolic Exhortation "The Joy of the Gospel," November 24, 2013.

“ Que se niegue a sí mismo, tome su cruz y me siga ”

Primer anuncio de Jesús a sus discípulos de lo que se avecina y que no es fácil de aceptar. Realmente los discípulos no habían entendido lo que significaba Jesús. Su encuentro con el Maestro de Nazaret no había supuesto una renovación de su mente, seguían pensando como los hombres. La realidad del Hijo

de Dios no es seguridad, es compromiso, responsabilidad, posibilidad... pero desde otras claves, que no son más extrañas y difíciles, sino más humanas. La realidad humana se da y crece entre los demás, con los demás. Yo sé quién soy, los otros me llaman, me permiten tomar conciencia de mi identidad.

Claves más humanas y, por tanto, humanizadoras, son aquellas que tienen en cuenta a los otros, al Otro. Tener en cuenta a los demás sólo se hace realidad en proporción a la capacidad de olvidarse de uno mismo, de vaciarse para dejar espacio a los otros, al Otro. Jesús, da muestras con su comportamiento, de quiénes son los más importantes y como acoger y acompañar, parece ser que esta opción y este compromiso solidario no es bien visto por el sistema, por el "status quo" de su tiempo. Había que eliminarlo... ¿Dónde podía descansar la seguridad que buscaban sus discípulos? ¡Esto es un fracaso!

Quien quiera seguirme que se niegue a sí mismo, cargue con su cruz y me siga. (Mt 16,24) Negarse uno mismo, no es renunciar a lo que somos, no es sacrificar la propia vida... Es alcanzar la lucidez de lo que significa Dios en nosotros. Y cargar con la cruz, no se limita a aceptar nuestros defectos y limitaciones, sino, más bien aceptar las consecuencias de nuestra fidelidad, la respuesta que podamos provocar en los demás...

La identidad de cada ser humano es importante, somos obra de Dios irrepentible, cada uno es una "palabra" de Dios, participantes, pertenecientes, creadores, definidores de la obra de Dios. Y si la identidad es importante, la misión es necesaria, ambas se complementan, se precisan. Identidad y misión, realidad consciente que nos pone en camino, y si es el camino del Señor, nos aleja de la acomodación, nos invita a ir siempre más allá, por ejemplo: A vosotros os digo: Amad a vuestros enemigos, tratad bien a los que os odian; bendecid a los que os maldicen... (Lc 6, 27-28).
