Cemetery of the Innocents

Dr. and Mrs. Godfrey's Residence

Elizabethtown, Kentucky

3,000 small crosses will be installed again this year on the lawn of Dr. and Mrs. Bill Godfrey, at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Ring Road and Pear Orchard Road in Elizabethtown. Cross installation will begin at **11am next Saturday, October 28th.** Volunteers for three functions will be needed: Assemblers, Runners, and Installers. Organization of the work is described below.

First, an appeal for precision.

Using careful alignment of the crosses, we want to capture eyes in order to engage hearts and minds to know the enormous number of abortions that are committed **every day** in the United States of America.

Surely, there is no perfection in this world. But aiming for precision will bring us closer to it. Attention to detail in every action we take will show up in the finished project.

Organization of the Work

Assemblers. Using a #2 phillips head screwdriver, Assemblers align the crossmember of the cross to a 90 degree angle with it's vertical member then tighten the screw "snuggly."

Runners. Carry crosses to their paint marked installation positions in the field, being careful to avoid stepping on cross position markings or crosses already delivered or installed.

Installers. Using *rubber* mallets (to avoid damage to the crosses), install crosses into the **Center of the paint mark** with the cross arm on the Ring Road side. (If the ground is dry and hard, a pilot hole may be found in the paint mark.) Installers should erect crosses vertically and properly aligned. Crosses should be driven in deep enough to remain in place despite wind and weather but not so deep that they will be impossible to remove. Knee pads could be useful for this work.

Clothing should be appropriate to the weather. Consider wearing gloves, warm socks, water proof/resistant footwear, hat, earmuffs or hooded sweatshirt.

Please bring a #2 phillips head screwdriver and a rubber mallet, if you have them.

Conscientious volunteers are needed. **This is a service hours earning opportunity for our student volunteers.** Please come and help us with this fine family activity. Thank you.





XXIX Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

En la Semana 29 del Tiempo Ordinario, la Liturgia va a seguir invitándonos a profundizar en el horizonte cristiano de la madurez humana: aprender a dar a Dios lo que es de Dios.

A través de una situación complicada como lo es contraponer lo que pertenece a este mundo con lo que pertenece a Dios, el Evangelio (Mt. 22, 15-21) va a hacernos caer en cuenta de una de las mayores convicciones de la vida y la fe: todo es de Dios.

De Dios es el mundo, la vida, las personas, nuestras alegrías y nuestras tristezas. Y de Dios, principalmente son los pobres, los pequeños y los frágiles de este mundo. La convicción cristiana de que "todo es de Dios", nos pone frente a frente con lo más radical de la vida: nada nos pertenece.



En este evangelio sorprende 'el elogio' de los fariseos a Jesús: "Maestro, sabemos que eres sincero y que enseñas con verdad el camino de Dios, y que nada te arredra, porque no buscas el favor de nadie". Aunque haya sido dicho con malicia por parte de los fariseos, encierra una profunda verdad. Pero una verdad que sólo lo es porque está marcada por la bondad de Jesús.

La verdad de Jesús es su bondad, porque es un hombre que con hechos y palabras se ha convertido en el amparo de todo el que le busca. Una verdad tan gratificadora que traspasa toda lógica humana, ofreciendo paz y descanso. Una verdad tan tierna que sabe recomponer y dar sentido a la enfermedad, a los problemas, incluso a la muerte. Toda esta verdad de Jesús es con la que tropieza tanto el fariseísmo de ayer como el de nuestro tiempo.




