***XXX Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario***

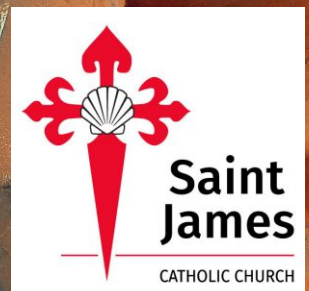
El evangelio de Mateo de este domingo nos ofrece la disputa sobre el mandamiento más importante. Sabemos que se unen o se juntan dos textos Dt 6,5 y Lv 19,18 que eran citados frecuentemente en discusiones éticas rabínicas, pero la idea de unirlos tan estrechamente a manera de resumen de toda la Ley y los Profetas fue una idea creativa no solamente brillante, sino, de nuevo, profética, como sucede en todas estas disputas concluyentes en Jerusalén. Lo que asombra en el texto evangélico es la seguridad soberana con que afirma que no hay preceptos como estos, porque en ellos se apoya toda la ley y los profetas. El texto dice que el amor al prójimo es "semejante" (homoía) al primero, dando a entender un orden lógico, pero sin disminuir su importancia. Es más, aquí Jesús nos está llevando a la conclusión de que aunque Dios no es el hombre, lo que podemos llamar la experiencia del amor no es distinta, aunque sean distintos los objetos o las personas amadas. Lo que le da gloria a Dios, precisamente, es que amemos al hombre como lo amamos a El; tendríamos que decir que no es posible amar a Dios más que al hombre.

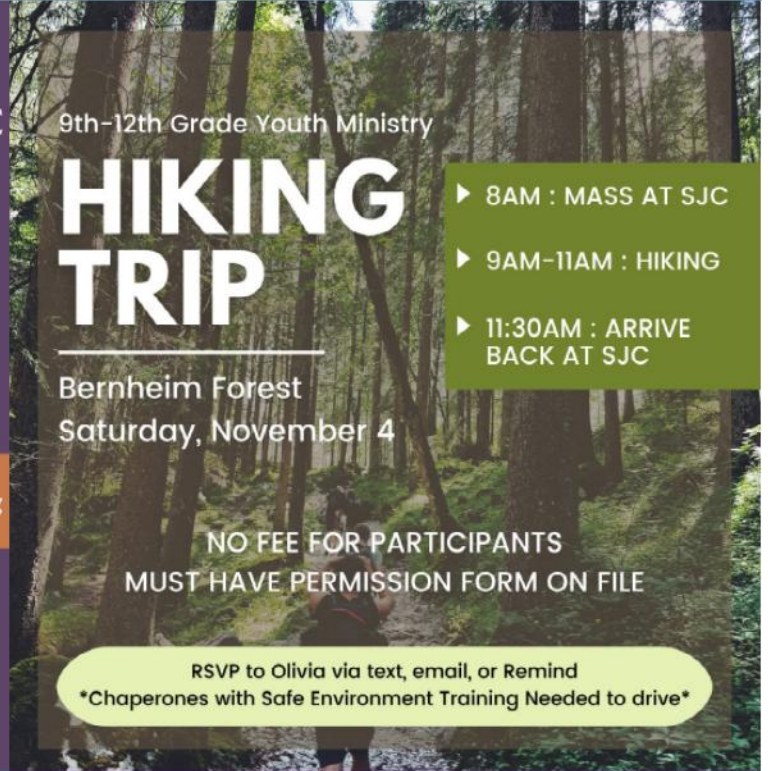

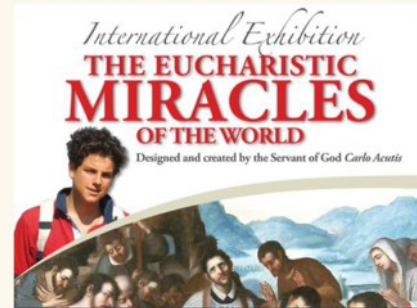
