



SOCIAL CONCERNS

Easter is a Season



Just as Sunday is one day out of seven, so the Easter season, a period of 50 days, is approximately one-seventh of the year. The Easter season, a time of special rejoicing and celebration of the Resurrection of Christ, is the "Great Sunday" of the year. The liturgical prayers and readings focus on the Resurrection and the effects that it has on believers and on the world. The Acts of the Apostles is a book of Scripture that provides the source of most of the readings of the Easter Season, and it shows the vigor with which the apostles proclaimed the Resurrection and brought many to the waters of baptism to share the new life of Christ. This season is a celebration of life, and leads us all to a deeper commitment to proclaim, celebrate, and serve the gift of human life.

...As we are transformed by Easter and grow in God's love, we grow in our deep appreciation for the gift of life (natural and supernatural), and our appreciation of the body. One key theme of the culture of death is the false separation of the body from the person. In other words, people "do what they want with their bodies," and even look the other way when the bodies of children are aborted, because they often believe that the body is not important, or is not as much an aspect of the person as is the soul. But the physical resurrection of Christ is a revelation of the sacredness of the human body, and of the fact that the love we are called to have, the commandments we are called to obey, and the repentance we are called to practice all involve a deep reverence for physical human life. ~ Priests for Life ~

Tercer domingo de Pascua ¿Culpa o destino?

Pedro parece ser bastante duro con sus oventes en la primera lectura. Dice que entregaron a Jesús, lo negaron ante Pilato, pidieron que se liberara a un asesino en su lugar y mataron a Jesús. Debieron haber pensado que estaban condenados. De repente, les dice que simplemente eran ignorantes y que Dios había planeado todo esto hace mucho tiempo. Entonces, ¿está diciendo que la muerte de Jesús es culpa de ellos o simplemente del destino?

La respuesta, por supuesto, es que es culpa de todos. Nuestros pecados son la razón de la muerte de Jesús. Negamos a Jesús cuando elegimos ser egoístas en lugar de amar. Lo entregamos cuando nos decimos a nosotros mismos que estamos demasiado ocupados para tomarnos el tiempo para orar. Pedimos que se libere a Barrabás en lugar de a Jesús cuando insistimos en hacer las cosas a nuestra manera en lugar de a la manera de Dios. Crucificamos a Jesús cuando seguimos a la multitud en lugar de seguir al Señor.

Solo es "destino" en el sentido de que nuestros pecados necesitaban ser perdonados y el plan de Dios para la salvación fue a través de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús. ¿Eso significa que nuestros pecados causan que suceda algo en el pasado? Había pecadores mucho antes de la época de Jesús y Dios sabía que habría pecadores después de eso. Dios también planeó perdonar a cualquiera que se arrepintiera de sus pecados. En cierto sentido, Jesús murió por aquellos que merecían ser castigados por el pecado, y también por aquellos que merecerían castigo en el futuro. Resucitó de entre los muertos para mostrar que el perdón de Dios nos levanta de la culpa a una nueva vida.

Pedro no estaba haciendo que los oyentes se sintieran culpables. Después de todo, estas son buenas noticias. Dios planeó todo esto para mostrar cuánto nos ama. Nuestra respuesta debe ser de alegría porque somos perdonados gracias a ese amor. Lo único que tenemos que hacer es decirle a Dios que lo sentimos, decirlo en serio y comenzar a vivir nuestra respuesta de amor. Los pecados pueden ser culpa nuestra, pero el Amor es nuestro destino. Third Sunday of Easter Fault or Fate?

Peter seems to be pretty tough with his listeners in the first reading. He says they handed Jesus over, denied him before Pilate, asked for a murderer to be released in his place, and put Jesus to death. They must have thought they were doomed. Suddenly, he tells them they were just ignorant. And that God had planned all this long ago. So is he saying Jesus' death is their fault, or just fate?

The answer of course is that it's everyone's fault. Our sins are the reason for Jesus' death. We deny Jesus when we choose to be selfish instead of loving. We hand him over when we tell ourselves we are too busy to take time to pray. We ask for Barabbas to be freed instead of Jesus when we insist on doing things our own way rather than God's way. We crucify Jesus when we follow the crowd instead of following the Lord.

It is only "fate" in the sense that our sins needed to be forgiven and God plan's for salvation was through Jesus' death and resurrection. Does that mean our sins cause something in the past to happen? There were sinners long before Jesus' time and God knew there would be sinners after that. God also planned to forgive anyone who repented their sins. In one sense, Jesus died for those who deserved to be punished for sin, and also for those who would deserve punishment in the future. He rose from the dead to show that God's forgiveness raises us up from guilt to a new life.

Peter wasn't laying a guilt trip on the listeners. After all, this is good news. God planned all this to show how much he loved us. Our response should be one of joy that we are forgiven because of that love. All we have to do is tell God we are sorry, mean it, and start living our response of love. Sins may be our fault, but Love is our fate. *Tom Schmidt*




The last pictorial church directory at Saint James was printed in 2018.

We also ask that you label or identify any flower arrangements that you place on top of monuments. We have received a few calls that arrangements have been stolen or removed. Often this is not the case, but rather high winds have caused the flower arrangements to come loose and blow across the cemetery. Our volunteers pick them up along the fence. If there is identification on the bottom of your arrangement, then we can place it back on the monument. We store unidentified arrangements for a period of time in our shed on the property.

If you are missing a floral arrangement from your loved ones headstone, then please call Dan Pawley at 270-401-9117 and we can meet at the cemetery to see if we have retrieved your arrangement.




